

The Best Strategy for Life

As we watched my daughter's basketball game from the bleachers, I heard the coach utter a single word to the girls on the court: "Doubles." Immediately, their defensive strategy shifted from one-on-one to two of their players teaming against their tallest ball-holding opponent. They were successful in thwarting her efforts to shoot and score, eventually taking the ball down the court to their own basket.

When Solomon, the writer of Ecclesiastes, grapples with the toils and frustrations of the world, he too acknowledges that having a companion in our labors yields "a good return" (4.9). While a person battling along "may be overpowered, two can defend themselves" (v.12). A friend nearby can help us up when we fall down (v.10).

Solomon's words encourage us to share our journey with others so we don't face the trials of life alone. For some of us, that requires a level of vulnerability we're unfamiliar or uncomfortable with. Others of us crave that kind of intimacy and struggle to find friends with whom to share it. Whatever the case, we mustn't give up in the effort.

Solomon and basketball coaches agree: having teammates around us is the best strategy for facing the struggles that loom large on the court and in life. Lord, thank you for the people you put in our lives to encourage and support us.

Who has helped you through a difficult time? Who could use your support and encouragement? How will you help them?

God gives us friends to help face life's battles.




I need the Eucharist for many reasons.

The Eucharist grounds me. On the days when I go to Mass but feel distant, distracted, or spiritually dry, it snaps me to attention. My thoughts might stray during the homily, but not while receiving the Eucharist; the feel and taste of the host on my tongue always bring me back to the present. The Eucharist anchors me in the reality of here and now.

The Eucharist makes me think of the holiness of food. There is no more concrete act of love than to feed another person; there is no more vivid sign of community than to gather for a meal. The Eucharist, when I let it, reminds me that the meals I prepare for my family are holy and that the gatherings of my friends for brunch or of my coworkers for birthday cake are holy, too. The Eucharist challenges me to see those encounters in this light.

The Eucharist reminds me of the power of sacrificial love. As a priest I know once said, "In the Eucharist, Jesus makes Himself so small for you." He's small enough to fit in my cupped palm. It's a remarkable thing to make oneself tiny, humble; most of us try our hardest to avoid that. Jesus does it, day after day, for every one of us. The Eucharist challenges me to love like that.

The Eucharist is a hint of Heaven. This close encounter with Jesus that I have every week: it's a taste of the life beyond this one, an intimate communion with God that we can only begin to imagine. In the sometimes messiness of human life, a life full of uncertainty or the chase for success, the Eucharist reminds us that this world isn't all there is.

Next Week's Readings—2nd June 2019 The Ascension of the Lord



Reading 1

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." When they had gathered together they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" He answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."

Lk 24:46-53

Jesus said to his disciples: "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold I am sending the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." Then he led them out as far as Bethany, raised his hands, and blessed them. As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken up to heaven. They did him homage and then returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and they were continually in the temple praising God.



Reflection Lift up your hearts

The day of the Lord's triumphant return to his Father is not a day for narrowness or sadness. Rather, it is a day for openness and joy. Therefore, let us lift up our hearts. Let us raise up your minds. Let our spirits soar and be free. For sin and evil and death have been overcome. We know nothing of the mystery of the beyond. All we have is his word:

"'Where I am, you too will be."

Lord, you have kindled in our hearts the hope of eternal life. Guard this hope with your grace, and bring it to fulfilment in the kingdom of heaven.
