FOOD TO SHARE

I know some people who think the Mass never ends – that it just continues outside the Church as they live the Gospel.

Imagine if the Communion procession would keep moving right out the door after Communion to feed our world that is starving for peace, companionship, and forgiveness.

Jesus makes it clear in this week's Gospel. He gives his bread for "the life of the world." This means that each Sunday's Gospel, homily, prayers, and Communion aren't really for us. Mass is for the world. Mass feeds our deepest hungers, so that we can take strength, hope, and peace into the world.


Sometimes Catholics don't see the connection between Sunday and the other six days of the week. But it's there. Classmates need our acceptance. Family members need our forgiveness. Opponents in sports need our team-spirit. People at work need our honesty. Poor and sick people need our compassion.

The more we give all that, the more we'll need Mass to recharge. The more we go to Mass, the more convinced we will be to give all that.

I remember a school community service program where a group of young people spend a week with me at a soup kitchen. One day a couple of us talked about how our daily service there made us "hungrier" for our time at Mass.

Not hungry for Mass? Try living the Gospel even more radically this week and see what that does.

How might your understanding of Communion change if you envision yourself sharing part of your host with people you see each day of the week?

Reading 1

Prv 9:1-6

Wisdom has built her house, she has set up her seven columns; she has dressed her meat, mixed her wine, yes, she has spread her table. She has sent out her maidens; she calls from the heights out over the city:

"Let whoever is simple turn in here; To the one who lacks understanding, she says, Come, eat of my food, and drink of the wine I have mixed!

Forsake foolishness that you may live; advance in the way of understanding."

Reading 2 **Eph 5:15-20**

Brothers and sisters:

Watch carefully how you live, not as foolish persons but as wise, making the most of the opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not continue in ignorance, but try to understand what is the will of the Lord. And do not get drunk on wine, in which lies debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and playing to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks always and for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God the Father.

Gospel

Jn 6:51-58

Jesus said to the crowds:

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within

you.

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."
