RESURRECTION SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM

Our parish offers sacramental programs for Catholic children who do not attend a Catholic school. Any child who is eligible to participate in sacramental program, must have already been baptised. We offer three programs annually, corresponding to the three sacraments of Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation. Each program runs for five weeks. We have trained Catechists who will present the classes.

The sacramental programs offered at Resurrection are as follows:

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Ages 8 and older) - Parent information night Tuesday 4th February 2020

Commitment Masses 15th & 16th February.

Classes will commence on Tuesday 18th February or Thursday 20th February at 4.00pm. There are 5 sessions before the Rite of Reconciliation - March 24th or 26th at 7.30pm.

The Sacrament of First Eucharist (Ages 9 and older) - Parent information night 16th April 2020

The Sacrament of Confirmation (Ages 12 and older) - Parent information night 11th June 2020

Enrolments are now open for 2020.

Next Week's Readings — 9th February 2020 Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Reading 1 IS 58:7-10

Thus says the LORD:

Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed; your vindication shall go before you, and the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard.

Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer, you shall cry for help, and he will say: Here I am! If you remove from your midst oppression, false accusation and malicious speech;

if you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday.

R. (4a) The just man is a light in darkness to the upright.

Reading 2 1 COR 2:1-5

When I came to you, brothers and sisters, proclaiming the mystery of God, I did not come with sublimity of words or of wisdom.

For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you

except Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

I came to you in weakness and fear and much trembling,

and my message and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of Spirit and power, so that your faith might rest not on human wisdom

but on the power of God.

Gospel MT 5:13-16

Jesus said to his disciples:

"You are the salt of the earth.

But if salt loses its taste, with what can it be seasoned?

It is no longer good for anything

but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

You are the light of the world.

A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden.

Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket;

it is set on a lampstand,

where it gives light to all in the house.

Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father."
