Reading 2

1 COR 2:6-10

Brothers and sisters:

We speak a wisdom to those who are mature,

Rather, we speak God's wisdom, mysterious,
hidden,
which God predetermined before the ages for our
glory,
and which none of the rulers of this age knew;
for, if they had known it,
they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard,
and what has not entered the human heart,
what God has prepared for those who love him,
this God has revealed to us through the Spirit.

For the Spirit scrutinizes everything, even the

MT 5:20-22A, 27-28, 33-34A, 37

Jesus said to his disciples:

"I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses
that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not
enter the kingdom of heaven. "You have heard
that it was said to your ancestors, You shall not
kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment.
But I say to you, whoever is angry with brother
will be liable to judgment.

"You have heard that it was said, You shall not
commit adultery.

But I say to you, everyone who looks at a woman
with lust has already committed adultery with her
in his heart.

"Again you have heard that it was said to your
ancestors, Do not take a false oath,
but make good to the Lord all that you vow.

But I say to you, do not swear at all.

Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.'
Anything more is from the evil one."

Stewardship Reflections

*"For I tell you, unless your
righteousness exceeds that of the
scribes and Pharisees, you will
never enter the kingdom of heaven."
(Matthew 5:20)*

*The scribes and Pharisees lived
according to the letter of the law, and
they used this to elevate themselves
above the other people. Jesus is clear
– it's the love that you have in your
heart that will get you to heaven.
Simply following church rules out
of obligation, not love, does not put
you on the path to heaven. Attending
Mass on Sunday and then gossiping
about a fellow parishioner on the
parking lot is an example of a modern
day Pharisee.*
